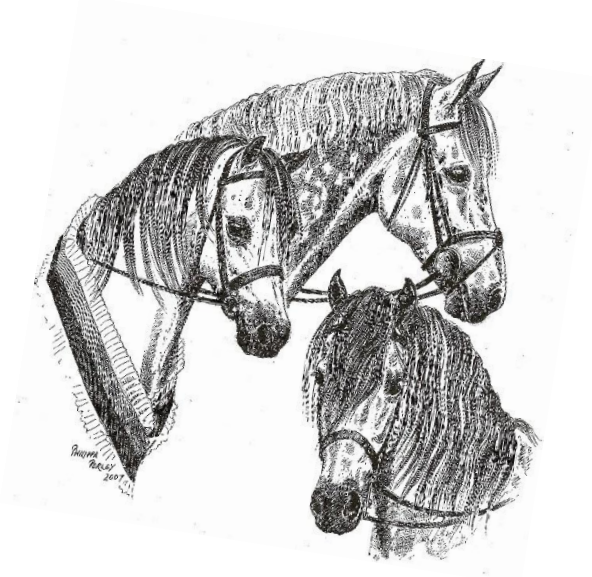

QUALIFIERS

ROYAL INTERNATIONAL HORSE SHOW

Classes 47-48, 49, 50, 70-74, 79 are qualifiers for the 2027 RIHS the highest placed pony not already qualified in the first three will qualify.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Owners and Riders must be current members with registered ponies of the BSPS to compete in all Classes.

Animals are restricted to the Breed Standard and the height limits laid down by the appropriate Breed Societies.

NO QUALIFICATION REQUIRED FOR ANY CLASSES except THE LONDON INTERNATIONAL SEMI FINAL

All classes are in accordance with BSPS Rules

NOVICE CLASSES – Animals that were a Novice on 1.1.2026 are eligible in accordance with BSPS Rules in the 2026 Rule Book

Except animals that have been placed 1st to 8th at RIHS, HOYS or Olympia/London International Horse Show (including the current year are not eligible)

PRETTY POLLY CLASSES Eligibility of entry in classes Pretty Polly classes is accordance with BSPS Pretty Polly rules.

CHALLENGE CLASSES Animals must not have qualified for the 2026 Horse of the Year Show.

All competitors must wear Body protectors in WHP classes

ORDER OF JUMPING AND DECLARATIONS

All competitors in WHP classes MUST declare to the collecting ring Steward at least 15 minutes before the commence of the class. Unless you do this the Stewards will assume that you do not intend to compete

Failure to attend at the set time, may result in disqualification.

Method of judging for Classes 98-100

Exhibitors enter the ring as a whole class on the right rein. (Classes may be split on the go round dependent on numbers at the judge's discretion). Exhibitors will walk, trot and canter, including change of rein and canter on the left rein before coming back to walk. No galloping on the go round. NO PULL IN. In the event of a tie performance marks take precedence.

Exhibitors will perform an individual display, this must include a walk, trot and canter on both reins, a free walk on a long rein, canter circle, extension at canter (not a gallop) on one rein, and a halt. Canter transitions must be executed on the straight, (not at a corner)

No stripping. Any suitable bridle, including a Micklem bridle, flash or grackle, nosebands etc, and a correctly fitted running martingale can be used. Coloured or plain brow bands can be used. Bit-less bridles and Running Gags are not permitted.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY AND RULES

1. Classes will be Judged in accordance with BSPS Rules.
2. Only tack and spurs that are permissible in the ring in BSPS classes ARE allowed on the showground while mounted.
3. Animals must be registered with the BSPS for 2026 to compete in all classes, except classes 3A & 4A, 24, 25, 43 & 44, 98-100 where competitors have 7 days after qualification to register pony, owner and rider with the BSPS.
4. Owners and riders must be BSPS members to compete in all classes, (See above regarding exception)
5. The Committee does not accept responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to any person, animal, or property at the Show. Exhibitors are warned that property has previously been lost at Shows and are therefore advised to take every precaution and not leave property unattended.
6. The Committee reserve the right to alter the times of the classes or the Judges.
7. Mounted exhibitors must adhere to horse walkways and riding areas.
8. **OBJECTIONS** must be made in writing with the objector's full name and address within 60 minutes of the completion of judging and must be lodged at the Secretary's Office together with the sum of £50 deposit. This sum will be returned if the objection is sustained, but if the objection is not sustained, the deposit will be forfeited to the funds of the Championships.
The Objection Committee will consist of Mrs S Thomas, Mrs S Emmerson and/or any other Official applicable.
Any objection against the judging of a class or championship must be referred to the BSPS in accordance with the Rules in the 2026 BSPS Rule and Show Handbook.
9. Any pony taking part will be liable to Dope Testing.
10. No marks will be displayed until after the presentation of awards.
11. It is strongly recommended that all exhibitors carry Public Liability Insurance for an adequate indemnity to protect against their negligence.
12. Neither the BSPS or any of its officers, assistants or stewards shall in any way be responsible for any loss, injury or damages that may happen to exhibitors or their assistants or other members of the public, or to any animal or property or to any vehicle brought into the Showground or on any premises used in conjunction with the Show, or while entering or leaving the same.
It is necessary all exhibitors carry Public Liability Insurance for an adequate Indemnity to protect against their negligence including any injury caused by their animals or property.
You accept being around horses and riding at any standard has inherent risk and that all horses may react unpredictably on occasions. You may fall off and could be injured, or be injured by another horse. By entering you accept these risks. It is advisable you take out your own Personal Accident insurance to cover you against the risks of injury.
13. **WARNING!!** Children, Motorcycles or Bicycles. Children **MUST NOT** be allowed to play on the bales of straw. **NO** Motorcycles or bicycles will be allowed to be ridden around the Showground or stabled area at any time. Bicycles or motorcycles may be impounded for the duration of the Show.

14. STABLING Please fill in your stabling form correctly. This will assist the Office and Stables Manager. Stabling will be available from 12 noon on Friday, 25th September 2026. Boxes cannot be booked for exhibitors to sleep in. NO cooking or smoking is permitted in the stable's areas. Stables allocated in different names cannot be allocated next to each other unless booked together at the same time.
15. Dress for the Evening Performance. Rider's blue or black coats with hunting ties (stocks), correct riding hats and leather or string gloves. No buttonholes or earrings allowed.
16. All entries and stabling fees MUST be paid in full when entries are made. NO entries will be accepted by telephone. Incorrect entries will be refused. ANY CHEQUE that is not honoured by the Bank will be returned to the exhibitor with their entries, and these WILL NOT be accepted. A £10 surcharge will be charged for stables cancelled prior to the closing date of entries.
17. **PONIES MUST NOT BE LEFT OVERNIGHT IN HORSEBOXES OR TRAILERS. CORRALS ARE NOT PERMITTED.**
18. **EQUINE PASSPORTS/INFLUENZA VACCINATION CERTIFICATES.** Exhibitors are required by DEFRA to carry with them Official Identity Documents (passports) for all horses and ponies when competing or travelling. Competitors are reminded that it is a DEFRA requirement that the Official Identity documents must be in the name of the legal owner within 30 days of ownership. Spot checks may be carried out at any show. Equine Inoculation Certificate for each of their exhibits must be in accordance with Rule 62a in the 2026 BSPS Rule and Show Handbook.
19. **WELFARE POLICY**
The Society will enforce its Welfare Policy at this show.
20. **CANCELLATIONS**
The BSPS shall be entitled to cancel the Heritage Championships Show.
 - 1) upon the serving of notice to the entrant of such cancellation, not less than 48 hours prior to the Heritage Championships Show: or
 - 2) an Event of Force Majeure occurs

For the purpose of this clause, "Event of Force Majeure" means an act of God including but not limited to fire, flood, earthquake, windstorm or other natural disaster, act of any sovereign including but not limited to war, invasion, act of foreign enemies, hostilities (whether war be declared or not) civil war, rebellion, revolution, insurrection, military or usurped power or confiscation, nationalisation, requisition, destruction or damage to property by or under the order of any government or public or local authority or imposition of government sanction embargo or similar action; law, judgement, order, decree, embargo, blockade, labour dispute including but not limited to strike, lockout or boycott; interruption or failure of utility service including but not limited to electric power, gas, water or telephone service; failure of the transportation of any personnel equipment, machinery supply or material required by BSPS for the provision of show services breach of contract by any essential personnel; any other matter or cause beyond the control of BSPS.

Upon the cancellation of the Heritage Championships Show, BSPS shall return all Championship Show entry fees to the entrants. However, in certain circumstances, the Society reserve the right to retain a fair percentage of the fees when the Society has incurred expenses.
